## School Improvement Package

Whakamārama School has been lucky to receive a one-off funding opportunity to accelerate property upgrade works. The board presented a project proposal to the Ministry for playground upgrades and this was accepted. This funding is a capital injection that will accelerate upgrade works at our school that would otherwise be deferred due to a lack of available funds.

Project works currently taking place at Whakamārama School are:

- Construction of hexagonal seating around the cherry trees at the front of the school
- Construction of a new sandpit (larger 😊)
- Replacement of decking outside the staff room and on the entrance steps leading up to the office
- Reroofing of the 'spaceship' playground
- New retaining timber cappings (edging) around the 4 playgrounds located around the school
- Replacement of plywood or timber on playground structures in desperate need
- Installation of new outdoor carpet leading up to the administration block (ramp and steps)
- Installation of outdoor carpet under the pavillion so that this can be used as a break out space for our learners



## Tree Trimming

It was great to bring in Cutting Edge at the end of 2020 to trim back overgrown trees around the hard courts, kindy fence line, garden shed and flax hedge of field.

## Working Bee - Corrections

It is always a pleasure to have the team from corrections come into our school prior to school starting to support a general tidy up of our grounds.

Across the year we will call out for further help with invitations to working bees to ensure our learning environment looks attractive.
