Road Safety update

We have been working alongside Western Bay Council Traffic Engineer, Ashley Hall and Traffic Safe Coordinator, Desiree Burborough, to ensure we are being as safe as we can. The school is on the list to have flashing school lights installed and as soon as we have a date for this we will let you know. As part of our review of systems we are trialling <u>flags instead of cones</u>. There has been concern that some motorists upon seeing the red cones are stopping, when the cones were really only for pedestrians to know if a car was coming or not.

To avoid confusion the new system is as follows - an orange flag raised, signals to pedestrians that there is a car coming. For drivers, the raised flag serves as a reminder to slow down.

Orange flag raised



Pedestrians - a car is coming do not cross

Drivers - please slow down

No flag



Pedestrians - no cars are coming - check the road carefully and cross

We are also aiming to manage where pedestrians cross. Please come to the <u>front of the cars</u> in the pick up bay and cross to between the cone and the fence then wait for no flag before checking carefully and crossing. Thank you all for your assistance with keeping our precious tamariki safe.


