

Reading Numbers up to 1000

Purpose:

The purpose of this activity is to help your child to read any number up to 1000.

Link to the Number Framework:

Number Sequence, Stage 5

What you need:

Calculator

What to do:

Ask your child to enter a hundreds number and read it to you. Check they have read it correctly.

Ask your child: *Using the calculator can you add 20 to the number? (press + 20 =)*

Read me what the number is? (Check they are correct)

Does that make sense?

What to expect your child to do:

To read the numbers correctly.

To check that the calculator answer makes sense and they haven't press the wrong buttons.

Variation:

Extend the activity to include thousands numbers.

He Kupu Māori:

tātaimai	calculator
tāpiri (hia)	add
tāpiritanga	addition
otinga	result/answer
pānui (hia)	read

He Whakawhitinga Kōrero:

- Tuhia te tau 'toru rau whitu tekau mā rima' ki te tātaimai. (*Write the number 375 on the calculator.*)
- Tuhia he tau 'rau' ki te tātaimai. (*Write a hundreds number on the calculator.*)
- Pānuihia mai te tau? (*Read the number to me.*)
- Tāpirihia te rua tekau ki tēnā tau. (*Add 20 to that number.*)
- He aha te otinga? Pānuihia mai. (*What is the result? Read it to me.*)
